# 4. How long will you keep my data?

We will not keep your data for any purpose longer than necessary to fulfill the original or a compatible purpose, except for the following exceptions:

- There is a legislative requirement to do so (for example, HMRC requirements)
- Resolve disputes
- Prevent fraud
- Enforcement of our terms and conditions

Where any of these exceptions apply, your data will only be used for the relevant legitimate purpose and not be used for any other purpose, such as marketing.

After it is no longer necessary to retain your data, we dispose of it securely.

#### 5. Where is my data stored?

Your data is stored securely, and is accessible only to personnel that have the authority to view the information. It may be transferred to staff who operate outside of the Economic European Area (EEA) who are employed by our parent company in the United States, in which case the third country's data protection laws will have been approved as adequate by the European Commission or other applicable safeguards will be in place.

- You have the right, with some exceptions and qualifications, to ask us to provide a copy of any personal data we hold about you
- If the information we hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete, you can notify us and ask us to correct or supplement it
- If you have a complaint about how we have handled your data, you may be able to ask us to restrict how we use your data while your complaint is being resolved. If you are dissatisfied with the outcome of an investigation into a complaint, you have the right to refer it to the Information Commissioners Office (ICO) via email (<a href="https://ico.org.uk/global/contact-us/email">https://ico.org.uk/global/contact-us/email</a>), or phone 030312311113, or write to the Information Commissioners Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Chesire, SK9 5AF, England.
- You can ask us to erase your data in the following circumstances:
  - By withdrawing your consent for us to use it
  - If it is no longer necessary for us to use your data
  - If you object to the use of your data and we don't have a good reason to continue to use it
  - If we haven't handled your data in accordance with our obligations
- You can raise an objection to the processing of your data if you disagree that we have a legitimate business interest to process it. You can also object to us using your data for direct marketing purposes.
- You have the right to request a transfer of your data to a third party.
- If you have given us your written consent to obtain information, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. Once we receive your notice of withdrawal, we will cease processing your data unless we have any other lawful basis on which to continue processing it.

If you wish to exercise these rights please contact a member of staff, who will direct your request to our data privacy controller. Before responding to your request, we may ask for specific information to confirm your identity.
